About Jakob

Born in 1971. M.Sc.E.E. Works in IT. Visited every 196 countries in the world between 1994 and 2019 - possibly as the worlds youngest hobby and family traveller. One of presently 4 danes and a little over 200 people world-wide who has visited every country on the planet. My family - Jonas b. 2009, Ava b. 2006 and Charlotte b. 1976 - have travelled to 60+, 75+ and 120+ countries respectively. All trips have been a 100% self-financed.

During his travels Jakob has been detained by military police in Conakry, Guinea and has been sentenced to deportation in Libya. He has survived a fatal bus crash in Venezuela and has bribed his way into Yemen. Additionally he has reported from three very special ceremonies that rarely (or never) previously have been documented by western media.

In total Jakob has travelled for more than 5,5 years. As a freelance journalist and photographer he has written travel articles from more than 50 countries published by danish newspapers Berlingske, BT, BT Metro, Jyllands-Posten and Jysk Fynske Media. Previously he was editor in chief of 'Globen' - member magazine for the Travellers Club of Denmark. He has held more than 20 public travel presentations for danish organisations AOF/LOF, for Cafe Globen and five years in a row for the official annual 'Cultural Night of Copenhagen'.
